

INSTRUMENT OF GOVERNMENT

(made in accordance with s20 Education Act 2002 as amended)

1. The name of the school is Brimpton Church of England Primary School.
2. The school is a voluntary controlled school.
3. The name of the governing body is 'The Governing Body of Brimpton Church of England Primary School'.
4. The governing body shall consist of:
 - a) two parent governors
 - b) one LA governor
 - c) one staff governor
 - d) one head teacher
 - e) two foundation governors
 - f) three co-opted governors
5. The total number of governors shall be 10.
6. The Oxford Diocesan Board of Education shall be entitled to appoint foundation governors.
7. The school has a Trust Deed dated 2nd November 1844.
8. Recognising its historic foundation, the school will preserve and develop its religious character in accordance with the principles of the Church of England and in partnership with the Church at parish and diocesan level.
The school aims to serve its community by providing an education of the highest quality within the context of Christian belief and practice. It encourages an understanding of the meaning and significance of faith, and promotes Christian values through the experience it offers to all its pupils.
9. This instrument of government comes into effect on 25 September 2014
10. This instrument was made by order of West Berkshire Local Authority on 25 September 2014
11. A copy of this instrument is supplied to every member of the governing body (and the head teacher if not a governor), any trustees and to the Oxford Diocesan Board of Education.
