Term 2026

Science- Animals including Humans Movement and Nutrition

Exploring the role of skeletons and muscles, learning how the body uses energy and what constitutes a balanced diet.

Topic The Egyptians

We will explore:-

Gift of the Nile, the iconic images of pyramids, the centrally important religious beliefs and the way we can work out details of people's daily lives by interpreting the fragments of evidence that have survived.

We will use some artefacts from the Newbury Museum and there will be a home learning topic on The Pyramid

Plans derived from Key stage History, Planbee and Twinkl.

English – Leon and the Place Between by Angela McAllister.

Throughout the sequence of learning children will explore the author's language and use it as the basis for their own descriptive writing. They will explore the characters' thoughts and emotions and take part in drama activities, leading to writing in role and the creation of dialogue. Using the structure of the original story, children will plan their own version of the story where their own character enters a magical world. Plans derived from The Literacy Tree

RE – In this unit, pupils will learn about the concept of 'Gospel' which tells the story of the life and teaching of Jesus. They will learn about the calling of the first disciples and how Christians today try to follow Jesus. Pupils will find out about Jesus' actions towards other people and what example these set for the actions of Christians today.
